

Introduction to Greek Second Edition is an introductory text to Classical Greek. It is designed for the first full year course and it concentrates on the basics in a way that allows the material to be covered easily in courses that meet three times a week over the course of two semesters. The focus of the text is on grammar with slightly altered readings drawn chiefly from the works of Xenophon and Herodotus. Shelmerdine's book is extremely well laid out with clear tables and large easy to read text. Her table of contents is incredibly detailed making it very easy to find each topic. Her chapter vocabularies are very helpfully divided into two parts.
